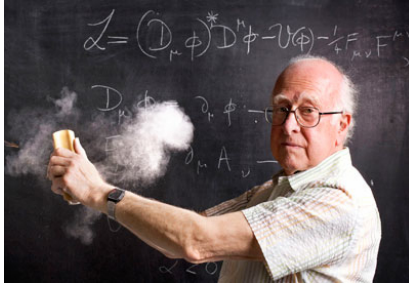

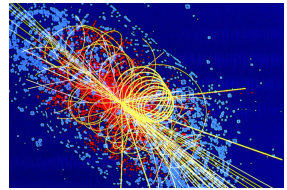
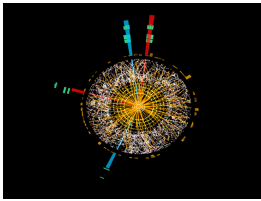


Peter Higgs, Nobel-prize winning

Peter Higgs' 90th Birthday Card Competition

- Entries should be sent to Jenni Smillie, Higgs 90 Competition, JCMB, Peter Guthrie Tait Road, Edinburgh EH9 3FD by **15 May 2019**
- The competition is open to all children aged 3 and over at primary school or nursery in Scotland
- Cards should be no larger than A4 when folded
- Entries should have name, class and school/nursery on the back. This will be used to acknowledge entries and notify winners and will not be stored or used for any other purpose.
- Entries will be judged in 3 age-groups: nursery/P1, P2-P4 and P5-P7.
- Entries will be judged by a panel before they are passed to Peter Higgs. Winning entries will then be displayed in the Higgs Centre for Theoretical Physics.
- By submitting an entry you give permission for an image of it to be used for publicity purposes.
